In 1776, Franciszek Biedrzycki goes to court to testify for his wife Petronella Milewska that Wawrzyniec and Jan Milewski the sons of Balthasar Milewski have given Petronella a cut to her left eye. The eye is black and blue, two cuts to the head with the skin pulled away and bloody. Franciszek Biedrzycki got an ulcer below the left hand with a large black and blue mark.
