In 1608, the noble Andrzej the son of the dead Wawrzyniec Chelchowski of Chelchi Salki has repaid the noble Jakub Chelchowski the son of the dead Felician Chelchowski the sum of 86 groszy from a debt that was made in 1597.

On the feast of St. Phillip and Jakub 1610, the noble Andrzej Chelchowski the son of the dead Wawrzyniec of Chelchi Salki has borrowed 32 florens from Jan Chelchowski son of the dead Marcin of Chelchi Marmino.

In 1614, Wojciech son of the dead Andrzej Chelchowski of Chelchi Salki has received a dowry of 660 groszy from Jakub son of dead Abraham Nakielski of Nakety for the dowry of his future wife Helena Nakielska. He then is putting a lien of 50 groszy on his properties of Chelchi Salki and Chelchi Marmino for her dowry lien. He also owns land in Janotki.

The land is between MAciej on one side and Wojciech on the other side. Earlier that year she sold some land with her brother Wojciech to Szymon Maminski.

In 1632, the noble Wojciech Chelchowski the son of the dead Andrzej of Chelchi Salki has received from Wenslaw Batogowski the son of the dead Mikolaj of Batogowo Nagorki the sum of 76 polish florens, this was a down payment for the purchase of land in Chelchi Salki.

The next record states that there was transfer of land and the homes on the land.

In 1636, Wojciech Chelchowski the son of the dead Andzej and his sister Katarzyna Chelchowska with Adam Chelchowski the son of the dead Jakub are selling land to Szymon Maminski the son of the dead Jakub of Mamino.

In the next record Wojciech Chelchowski is borrowing money from Adam Chelchowski and he is also borrowing money from Szymon Biedzicki son of the dead Mikolaj from Biedrzyce Falki.

On the Feast of Corpus Christie 1637, Wojciech Chelchowski the son of the dead Andrzej of Chelchi Salki is borrowing money from his brother in law Bartlomiej Nakielski the son of the dead Jakub. Bartolomej is married to Dorota Chelchowska.

On the Feast of the Visitation 1637, Wojciech Chelchowski the son of the late Andrzej of Chelchi Salki has repaid Bartolomej Nakielski the sum of 26 polish florens Jakub Chelchowski is the brother of Wojciech.

On the week after the Ascension 1638, the noble Wojciech Chelchowski the son of the dead Andrzej has petitioned the court to end the quarrel between Jakub the son of the dead Walenty and Dorota Strzemasczna, his wife, Stanislaw son of the dead Stanislaw and his wife Jadwiga, Jan the son of the dead Wladislaw Batogowska and Jadwiga Chelchowska the wife of Walenty Glinki all from Chelchy Cibory and The Noble Walenty Chelchowski the son of the dead Jan Chelchowski. The Rozan tribunal court decreed that the sum of 420 Polish florens which came from the property of Chelchy Cibory should be divided 6 ways.

In 1646, Helena Nakielska the widow of Wojciech Chelchowski of Chelchy Salki and Adam and Marcin their sons is lowering the debt of Wojciech the son of Jakub Chelchowski and Dorota Gutowska, the sum of 50 zloty from the dowry lien of Tomasz Chelchowski the son of Mikolaj.

In the year 1649, the noble Eleanora Nakielska the widow of the dead Wojciech son of the dead Andrzej Chelchowski of Chelchy Salki is giving her daughter Marianna 10 Polish zloty.

In the next record she is giving her sons Adam, Marcin and Wojciech her villages in Chelchy Salki, Mamentki and Glinki Ziematy for the sum of 40 florens.

Notes for EMETHANCIA SALKI CHELCHOWSKA:

She had three husbands. The first was Maciej Damienski, the second was Maciej Rupinski in 1621 and the third in 1632 was Jan Zebrowski.

In 1621, the noble Emarantia Chelchowska the daughter of Andrzej Chelchowski and the widow of Maciej Damienski and the wife of Maciej Rupinski the son of Abraham Rupinski is stating the her father has repaid 78 Polish zloty to her minor son Adam Damienski that was borrowed in 1620.

In the next record she is renouncing claims to the estate of her husband Maciej Rupinski the son of Abraham Rupinski. She is doing this with the witness of her father Andrzej and Wojciech Chelchowski (her brother?).

On the Feast of Saint Dorothy, 1632, her future husband Jan Zebrowski the son of the late Tomasz from

Zebry put a lien on his property for 85 Polish florens. This was part of her dowry. Her brother Wojciech Chelchowski son of the deceased Andrzej borrowed 45 florens from Jan Zebrowski. Of this 45 florens 20 florens was used for her dowry.

In 1699, Maciej Chelchowski the son of the dead Wojciech Chelchowski of Chelchi Salki has repaid Maciej Stepnowski the son of the dead Stanislaw of Stepnowo Antigua the sum of 40 polish florens in payment of a debt.

In 1703, Maciej Chelchowski the son of the dead Wojciech Chelchowski has borrowed 42 florens from Marcin Stepnowski the son of the dead Maciej of Stepna. The land mortgaged is 2 tillable rows beginning at the gardens stretching to the road and extending to the border post of the creditor Wawrzyniec Maminski. 1 tillable row from the Rogale border to the border post of Franciszek Chelchowski.

Notes for MARIANNA JAZWINSKA:

Family paid 2 zloty 2 groszy to bury her. The Death record said her nickname was Rzepczyna.

In 1731, the Noble Marianna Jazwinska the widow of Maciej Chelchowski of Chelchi Salki is lending her son Jakub 80 Polish tynfs and he is mortgaging 1 tillable row from the road to the border of the Majkowski land between the border post of the dead Marcin Stepnowski and Rafalkowska on the other side., 2 tillable rows from the agricultural fields to the fields between the inherited lands of Chelchi Salki.

In the 1690 Rozan census he is listed as living in Chelchy Salki the son of Maciej.

In 1703, Tomasz Chelchowski the son of the dead Maciej Chelchowski of Chelchy Salki states that Jakub Strzemieczny the son of Jozef of Strzemiecznie repaid the 130 polish zloty a debt of the dead Pawel Strzemieczny. Piotr Strzemieczny and other inheritors of Pawel paid the other 40 Polish zloty. RZW 39 page 634 rekto

In the 1690 Rozan census he is listed as living in Chelchy Salki the son of Wojciech.

In 1679, her father, Adam the son of the dead Tomasz of Biedrzice Koziegłowy has given Adam Chelchowski the son of Wojciech of Chelchy Salki the sum of 100 Polish florens as a dowry for her marriage to Adam Chelchowski.

His mother Zofia was a witness to this record.

In 1682, Wojciech Chelchowski the son of the dead Wojciech Chelchowski of Chelchi Salki is repaying Wladislaw Golembiewski the sum of the dead Stanislaw 42 florens that the dead Walenty Chelchowski the son of the dead Wojciech borrowed.

In the next record it states that Wladislaw Golembiewski the son of the dead Stanislaw is repaying Wojciech Chelchowski the son of the dead Wojciech the debt that he owed him with the mortgage of Chelchi Cibory.

In 1787, Franciszek Kobylinski, Florian Krzyzewski, Tomasz Mienczewski, Jakub Kobylinski, Ignacy and Wawrzyniec Chrzanowski, Lucia widow of Walenty Kobylinski, Jozef Bielinski, and Jan Laziewski all owners of Budzyno Walendzieta are all summoned to be witnesses for Antoni Budziszewski and Pawel Wrobelski concerning the damages that occurred to the fields by the animals. Franciszek Kobylinski wounded two of the animals that damaged the fields. Many bad words were exchanged and Franciszek Kobylinski along with Wawrzyniec Chrzanowski and Jan Lasinski agreed to enclose 7 of the fields which would stretch from the meadows to the public fields to the village of Dombrowski.
