This was a mortgage of land in Biedzyce Kozięglowy and concerns Anna Kordowska daughter of dead Jakub, and Anna Kordowska the daughter of the dead Wojciech and the first wife of Wojciech Brussowski of Brusowo. He is to collect this money from Jan Chojnowski the son of the dead Jan. The Chojnowski family is as follows: Wojciech, Pawel, Jan, Marcin, Jakub, Piotr the sons of the dead Mikołaj Chojnowski. In 1684, the Noble Tomasz and Kazimierz sons of the dead Wojciech Kordowski of Biedzice Kosieglowy state that Ewa daughter of Wawrzyniec Biedrzycki and the first wife of Wojciech Glazewski and the second wife of Jakub Kordowski has transferred a lease on the property that had a debt of 200 zloty that was originally borrowed from the Kordowski family by Wojciech Glazewski. Tomasz and Kazimierz now hold this mortgage.

In 1685 on the Feast of St. Fabian the Martyr, the brothers Tomasz and Kazimierz Kordowski the sons of the dead Wojciech and Zofia Glazewska are splitting up their father's estate which consisted of property in Biedrzyce Kosieglowy, Nakul, Zychy and Batogowo Dzierlaty. The record states that their father died in 1641.

He will be paying him 620 Polish zloty for the land that lies between the border of Adam Biedrzycki on one side and Piotr Rzenicki on the other side of the land in Biedrzyce Kozielklowy.
In the next record, Pawel, son of the dead Jan Kordowski of Biedrzyce Kozielklowy, is stating that Tomasz son of the dead Wojciech Kordowski has repaid him 6 polish florens that he borrowed from him. The land that had been mortgaged was a tillable row from the klinowy stretching to the Rozabetween the border post of Adam Biedrzycki on one side and Piotr Rzenicki on the other side, this was inherited land in Biedrzyce

Kosieglowy.

In 1689, Tomasz Kordowski the son of the dead Wojciech Kordowski of Biedrzyce Kosieglowy is borrowing 20 florens from Ewa Budna the widow of Adam Biedrzycki. He has mortgaged 1 tillable row from the Makow Strata Road stretching from the Nakelsk fields to the inherited lands of Biedrzyce Kosieglowy.

Rozan Grodzkie Wieczyste book 37 page 728 rekto

In the 1690 census of rozan he is listed as the son of the dead Wojciech.

In 1697, Tomasz the son of the dead Wojciech Kordowski of Biedrzyce Kozielowy has borrowed 10 polish zloty from Kasper son of the dead Andrzej Maczenski. The land mortgaged is 1 tillable row from the Ryk stretching to the road and then to the border post of Pawel Kordowski on one side and Stanislaw Batogowski on the other side.

In 1699, Tomasz Kordowski the son of the dead Wojciech of Biedrzyce Kosieglowy states that Zofia Biedzicka the daughter of the dead Grzegosz Biedzicki and the widow of Jakub Batogowski is lending him money. He is mortgaging 2 tillable rows from the border of Suamek to the border post of Stanislaw Batogowski on one side and Jakub Kordowski on the other side. This is inherited land in Biedzice Kozielowy.

He land that was mortgaged was 2 tillable rows beginning at the Pichucha border and extending to the Makowska road between the border stone of Antoni Chrzanowski on one side and the land of Adam Karniewski on the other side. 1 tillable row beginning at the Makowska road and extending 400 meters between the border stone and the inherited land of Chrzanowo Tworki, the mortgage goes year to year.

On June 2, 1790, Adam Chrzanowski wrote a letter to the court giving a history of his life.

I was born In the village of Chrzanowo Tworki in the parish of Makow, my father was Tomasz Chrzanowski and my mother Rozalia Gasewska. I am nearly 36 years old and my Father died 20 years ago and my mother 3 years ago. I have 2 brothers and 1 sister living. I am the oldest, Antoni is the youngest and sister Marianna is married to Ludwik Chodkowski. I was sent by my father to school in Pultusk (the Jesuits had a school in Pultusk), and I was promoted to the Gramatyka when my father died my mother took me home. A few years past and I married Jadwiga Kordowska the daughter of Ludwik. I am now married to her for 15 years, I have now living 4 children a son Wawrzyniec and 3 daughters Jozefa, Joanna and Elzbieta. During the Konfederacy, Jozef Walczak a poor non noble and Jan Kalinowski also a poor man the son of the innkeeper and also from Chrzanowo asked me to become a member of the Konfederacy because they were members of the Konfederacy. We went to the village called Cupielo, there we found a tavern named Kiecpa. We went to the tavern there named Kiecpa and we started to drink liquor called Gorzalka. There were Jews there that were afraid of us and they began to violently scream. I left to go home and the Jews followed me through the woods where they hid. The Russian police came. They thought that I was a member of the Konfederacy and they took me to a jail in Karniewo there they kept me 2 Sundays and from there they took me to Przasnysz where they kept me for 1 1/2 Sundays. I received from them a penalty of 30 whips because of what I did in Cupielo. The Commendant then heard from the Jews and from other people that I did nothing wrong and they let me go. I did not hold anything against them. They returned my saber, 2 horses, and pistols that they had taken from me.

After this at the end of the Konfederacy, the late nobleman Dambkowski who was the Camerary threatened that I would be punished over what happened in the tavern in Cupielo. The Jew named Kiecpa and other Jews agreed with him. I gave him 7 red Polish zloty as a fine.

A few years later the late nobleman Antoni Glodkowski from Glodki convinced me to go the pig sty of the late Marcin Chrzanowski as he was afraid of the dogs. We went to Marcin Chrzanowski's (his nickname was Goraj). Glodkowski took a mare and rode it to the Bobowski forest where he fed the horse. Marcin Chrzanowski found me in the tavern and encouraged me to drink the whiskey until I was drunk. I then told him that Glodkowski stole the horse. However, Glodkowski then went to Chrzanowski and told him that he found the horse wandering in the woods. Then Marcin Chrzanowski with the Nobleman Tanski caught me riding from Makow to my house. They hit me and bound my wrist between two pieces of wood. They fined me and I had to mortgage my land for 40 Polish zloty to pay the fine. I settled this debt in Makow and the charges were dropped.

My next problem was when the wife of Pawel Pomaski gave me her mare with a saddle to sell it in Ciechanow. She told me that this mare was hers and not her husbands. I couldn't sell this horse in Ciechanow but I exchanged it for another horse paying an additional two and a half Zloty. Pomaski got information about this and wanted me to give him his horse back. I had to pay him 24 polish zloty for his horse.

Trouble seems to follow me. On the Feast of St. Stanislaw, I went to the fair in Przasnysz. Mr. Tanski who lives in the same village on the other side of the road from me had a horse that I borrowed without asking him. I needed to borrow this horse as it would take me too long to walk to the fair. I wanted to buy either a

male or female horse at the fair. Mr. Tanski noticed that his horse was missing and he followed me to Przasnysz. I had left his horse at the Przasnysz Burger's barn. Mr. Tanski found me without the horse walking to the fair. Wojciech Morawski came with Tanski and they caught me and bound my wrists between two pieces of wood. They also hit me. I tried to explain that I only borrowed the horse and I didn't hurt the horse. I had 14.5 Polish zloty in my pocket which they took and spent 5.5 of it on themselves. They took me to their house where I confessed that I had taken the horse to the Burger's stable. We went back to Przasnysz where they got the horse. We returned to Chrzanowo and spent the night there. Tanski then took me to Makow where I am held for 3 weeks. I have nothing further to say about this matter.

My next problem started and I had to appear in court a second time. I am not guilty of this new matter. The Jews blamed me that I had stolen grain from Marcin Chrzanowski. But this grain was taken my Chrzanowski's farm hand named Jan who is now dead. the farm hand, Jan appeared at my house one night and asked me to help him take the rye grain to Makow to sell. I asked him whose rye it was and he told me it came from his master Chrzanowski who had given it to him to sell. I gave him horses and together we went to Makow in the morning to sell this rye. We sold this rye to the Jew name Hyam Malowny. When we returned home, Mr. Szwiński from Chrzanowo took Jan and hit him. He took my cattle as a fine for taking the rye. He told me that he would return my cattle when he received the money from the sale of the rye. He said that this was not the first time that the servant Jan had stolen the rye. I thought that the Jew would give a fair weight for the rye, but he didn't. The Jew said that the rye did not weigh much and paid only 50 or 60 zloty for it., I was obliged to pay the Jew for the rest of the rye. After I paid the Jew, I received my cattle.

I am confessing that I as well as the Jews stole a horse and 3 or 4 geese from Pomaski at night. The Jew promised me that he would give me 3 of the geese but the late Marcin Chrzanowski took the geese and I had none or them.
